Motion was made to pay all utilities when due and to pay Mrs. Martha Cargile on every third

Monday of each month. Made by Mr. D. 0. Aldridge and duly seconded by Horris Morris, All present voted "Aye".

None Opposed.

Report from Art Postel on application to get \$1,600.000 of bonds approved by attorney general and

Water Rights Commission.

Motion for Resolution to enter into following contract with Postel Securities was made by Mr. A. J.

Laws and seconded by Landon Ramsay. Thereupon the question being called for after full discussion and

deliberation the members present voted "Aye". None Opposed

To the Board of Directors Franklin County Water District Mount Vernon, Texas

Gentlemen:

Completion of the District's portion of the financing of the lake on Cypress Creek requires the issuance of the remaining authorized but unissued bonds in the amount of \$1,600.000. The issuance of these bonds will require the approval of the Texas Water Rights Commission and the Attorney General of the State of Texas. To the end that the District may receive a premium on these bonds, authorized to be issued by order of the Board of Directors on November 212 1966. We are hereby granted the option to purchase them at one-hundred-two and one quarter (102-1/4) percent of par value plus accrued interest from the date of the bonds to date of delivery to us. This option is to remain in effect until midnight of the tenth day following the day the issuance of the bonds is given final approval by the Attorney General.
