MOTION was made by BILLY JORDAN, and SECONDED by ENNIS CHRISTENBERRY, to approve and make payments of bills and of any salaries that might come due before the next board meeting. MOTION was made by ENNIS CHRISTENBERRY, and duly SECONDED by BILLY JORDAN, to approve the 10% Leaseback for the Lovelace heirs. The President put the question, and after full discussion had thereon, all members present voted "AYE". NONE voted "NO". MOTION was made by K. P. LESTER, and duly SECONDED by A. J. LAWS, to authorize the President and Secretary to enter into the Lease Agreement with Mary Bolin and Sarah Rhoades Hamrick, in behalf on the Lovelace heirs. The President put the question and, after full discussion and deliberation, all present voted "AYE". NONE voted "NO". A copy of said Lease Agreement is attached hereto and made a part of these Minutes.

MOTION was made by K. P. LESTER, and duly SECONDED by A. J. LAWS, to authorize the President and Secretary to enter into a Right-of-Way and Channel Easement with the State Highway Department. The President put the question, and after full discussion and deliberation had thereon, all members present voted "AYE". NONE voted "NO". Copies of said Easements are attached hereto and made a part of these Minutes.

Lake Superintendent Horris Morris discussed the City of Mt. Vernon's method of payment for water. He made mention of the fact that boat ramp plans due in the mail today, had not been received. Mr. Morris reminded the Board of the October 8th meeting at the Country Club, indicating his plans of attending. It was brought out that all the Board hope to attend the organizational publicity meeting being formed by John P. Travis. Mr. Morris discussed the approaching hunting season, at which time the Board authorized Mr. Morris to have signs printed and posted on all district and leased property. Signs both for "No Hunting on District &/or Leased Property," and "No Firearms Allowed," are to be placed at vantage points around the lake. At this time, the Board authorized Mr. Morris to place a Public Notice in area newspapers about the warning posters. The notice will run for 2 weeks.

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Mr. Morris stated Mr. McFadden refused to sign easement for waterline right-of-way.

The Board recognized the use of Mr. Morris's Private boat for Franklin County Water District and Sheriff Department business.

A lengthy discussion was had pertaining to the Taxpayers Developments.

Mr. Woodrow Edwards reported to the Board that the Surveyors were 5 to 6 tracts behind in surveying. He stated land had been purchased but they could not get it surveyed. The Board authorized K. P. LESTER to check into this matter.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
