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MOTION was made by Billy Jordan., and duly SECONDED by Jearl Cooper, to authorize the President and Secretary to execute a Release of Vendor's Lien to B. C. G., Inc. The President put the question, and after full discussion and deliberation thereon, all members present voted "AYE". NONE voted "NO". The release when executed, will be attached hereto and made a part hereof.

MOTION was made by Billy Jordan, and duly SECONDED by E. L. Seay, to approve the Amendment to the Cypress Basin Operating Plan and to authorize the President and Secretary to execute same. The President put the question and, after full discussion and deliberation thereon, all members present voted "AYE". NONE voted "NO". A copy of the agreement, when executed, will be attached hereto and made a part hereof.

MOTION was made by E. L. Seay, and duly SECONDED by Jearl Cooper, to authorize Shirley Lykins to accept petitions of persons desiring to run in the district's election on behalf of the District's secretary. The President put the question and, after full discussion and deliberation thereon, all members present voted "AYE". NONE voted "NO".

MOTION was made by Billy Jordan, and duly SECONDED by E. L. Seay, to join the Chamber of Commerce. The President put the question and, after full discussion and deliberation thereon, all members present voted "AYE". NONE voted "NO".

MOTION was made by E. L. Seay, and duly SECONDED by Ennis Christenberry to approve a request from M & W Recreational Facility to lower their take-or-pay of 40 acre feet to 20 acre feet per annum, subject to approval by the Texas Water Development Board and the Texas Water Rights Commission. The President put the question and, after full discussion and deliberation thereon, all members present voted "AYE". NONE voted "NO".

Shirley Lykins presented:

- (1) A list of delinquent accounts;
- (2) A schedule of the new hospitalization premiums; and
- (3) A list of pending items.

She further reported that the negotiation period with South Franklin Water Supply Corporation is approaching.

The next regular meeting date falls on a holiday, therefore, the Board called the next meeting for Wednesday, February 23.

Ennis Christenberry retired from the meeting at this time.

The office manager reported that the annual audit was begun on February 4.

MOTION was made by E. L. Seay, and duly SECONDED by Jearl Cooper, to void the approval of a release of vendor's lien granted to John Wilhite on August 16, 1976. The President put the question and, after full discussion and deliberation thereon, all members present voted "AYE". NONE voted "NO".

The Board was enlightened as to the progress of the District's scrapbook, which was begun last summer. The scrapbook includes many items of interest in regard to the district's history and shall be updated periodically.

The office manager announced that January 31st marked the end of six months of the trial period of one-woman office management. She asked if there were any complaints or any suggestions that the Board members might wish to voice. There were none.

There being no further business, the Meeting was adjourned.
