NOTICE of the Meeting was given, stating the time, place, and purpose, all as required by Vernon's Ann. Civ. Statutes. Article 6252-17.

The Lake Patrol advised the Board of a MonArk Boat which had been used only slightly, which was available at a reduced price; whereupon, Motion was made by Ennis Christenberry, and SECONDED by Billy Jordan, to purchase said boat subject to the final approval of the Lake Patrol after he inspects same. The boat is to be equipped as presented. The President put the question and, after full discussion and deliberation thereon, all members present voted "AYE". NONE voted "NO".

MOTION was made by Billy Jordan, and SECONDED by E. L. Seay, to purchase a 1979 115 hp Chrysler motor to be put on the boat. The President put the question and after full discussion and deliberation thereon, all members present voted "AYE". NONE voted "NO".

Discussion was had regarding the need to advertise the proposed purchase, whereupon, MOTION was made by Ennis Christenberry, and SECONDED by Jearl Cooper, that a Resolution be adopted to authorize the publication of a NOTICE of such intent. Said Resolution is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

MOTION was made by E. L. Seay, and SECONDED by Billy Jordan, to issue a water permit to Gary Whatland for the water being used by Woodward & Clyde Engineering Firm. Said permit cost to be \$25.00. The President put the question and, after full discussion and deliberation thereon, all members present voted "AYE". NONE voted "NO".

Discussion was had concerning the repairing of 24 camper sites and seed and fertilizer to be purchased by the engineering firm for repair of the bare spots on the dam.

There being no further business, the Meeting adjourned.
